The webinar presented by Mr. Adjei-Darkwah, one of the few members decorated with 5 out of the PMI's 8 certifications, provided essential information to all interested in becoming PMP certified. It also presented an opportunity to explain in details the exciting discount offers to both members and non-members interested in writing PMP certification exam.

#### PMP Initiative Discount Offer

With this special discount offer, PMI members in good standing, with a valid Ghana Chapter membership subscription will have to pay \$341.00 for the PMP certification exam instead of \$405; non-member pays a discounted amount of \$480.00 for a full one-year membership subscription plus PMP certification examination fee.

To receive this discount, the candidate must have completed, submitted and received approval from PMI for his/her exam eligibility. An email should then be sent to [president@pmi-ghana.org](mailto:president@pmi-ghana.org) for the promotional code to effect the discount.

#### The PMP Exam

The exam is a time-constrained 4-hour exercise with 200 multiple choice questions, which can be taken at any PMI approved centre in Ghana and elsewhere. In April 2020, PMI successfully launched an alternative to the physical venue, which allows exam takers to sit for the exam in the comfort of their homes or offices. If you intend to go for this option, you must be sure to have a good/reliable internet connection with enough data, a laptop computer with webcam and other requirements to carefully look out for.

#### Re-Certification/Maintenance of Credential

The PMP certification, once obtained, must be maintained by renewing it every three years. Within this period, 60 Professional Development Units (PDUs) must be accrued, and a re-certification fee of \$60 paid. Failure to achieve these might lead to loss of the credential entirely.

The Q & A session saw questions from among the ninety-nine participants addressed by the facilitator and the President of the Ghana Chapter, Ms Jumoke Lafenwa.
