PM Excellence Oil and Gas Project of the Year Award

The **Oil and Gas Project of the Year Award** honours an oil and gas company that has demonstrated superior organizational management resilience and capabilities by:

- Delivering exceptional business value under extreme challenges
- Positive impacts on the society and the environment

Eligible

- **Project budget must be at least Ghc1 million.**
- Project of any type, from any industry or sector.
- Project from any geographic location in the country.
- The project must have been completed not more than 12 months before the nomination deadline.
- **The Lead Nominator does not require PMI Ghana affiliation.**

Not Eligible

- Projects completed over 12 months from the nomination deadline.
- Current PMI Ghana volunteer and/or PMI Ghana consultants are not eligible to apply for this award.

Number of Awards

- One winner will be awarded annually.
- PMI Ghana reserves the right not to select any finalists for a particular year if the evaluations performed indicate that the nominations do not meet the stated criteria.

Nomination

Overview

- One Lead Nominator with whom PMI Ghana will communicate regarding the nomination must be designated.
- The Lead Nominator does not require PMI Ghana affiliation.
- Review PMI Ghana General Nominations Guidelines.

1	Describe the project leadership, including key stakeholder relationships and executive sponsorship.

1	Describe how changes were documented and approved	
2	Describe what change-related complexities had to be overcome.	
3	Identify the key changes during your project and why they were key to your project.	
10. Lessons Learned		
Show that lessons learned from previous projects (if any) and from the submitted project were effectively integrated into the project and/or organization by answering the following:		
1	Describe the key lessons learned	
2	Describe how the integration of lessons learned (if they were) contributed to the success of the project.
